IMPORTANT NOTICE:

In application of the state of health emergency decreed by the Government of Côte d'Ivoire to fight the COVID-19 pandemic, teleworking arrangements have been put in place at MCA-Côte d'Ivoire since Tuesday March 24th, 2020. These procedures aim to guarantee the continuity of the teams' work and their full commitment to achieving the Compact's objectives while guaranteeing their security.

1. The Government of Côte d'Ivoire and the United States of America Government acting through the Millennium Challenge Corporation ("MCC") have signed on November 7th, 2017, in Washington, DC, the Grant Agreement for Côte d'Ivoire 's Compact Program in the amount of US\$ 524.74 million for the financing of two projects: The Abidjan Transport Project (ATP) and the Skills for Employability and Productivity Project (Skills Project). This agreement, for the benefit of the Ivorian populations came into effect on August 5th, 2019. MCA-Côte d'Ivoire intends to apply a portion of the proceeds of MCC Funding to eligible payments under a contract associated with this Invitation for Bids. Any payments made by the Employer under the proposed contract will be subject, in all respects, to the terms and conditions of the Compact and related documents, including restrictions on the use and distribution of MCC Funding. No party other than the Government and the Employer shall derive any rights from the Compact or have any claim to the proceeds of MCC Funding. 2. MCA-Côte d'Ivoire hereby invites all eligible Individual Consultants to provide the services of **community mobilization supervisor**. Individual consultants are invited to submit their curriculum vitae and financial proposal. MCA-Côte d'Ivoire will award to ten selected consultants a contract with a 12-months base period followed by one 12-months optional period and one 6-months optional period in accordance with the terms of reference. The exercise of the optional periods will depend on the consultants' performance based on set objectives.
3. The Supervisor needs to have the following qualifications:
 - A higher education degree (Bac+3) or equivalent in one of following fields: sociology, agronomy, education, local development, law, criminology, management science, economy, and any other related subject.



- At least 5 years of experience in community mobilization or rural animation (outreach, community mobilization, etc.) in the educational sector;
 - Have coordinated or supervised a team of at least 3 people in two different projects with the same complexity;
 - Good teamworking skills and ability to work under pressure.
 - Good writing skills ;
 - Capacity to interact with regional or local stakeholders,
 - Working knowledge of French (speaking, writing, reading) and the knowledge of at least one local spoken language in the operating area such as baoulé, dioula, bakwé or kroumen according to the chosen region (To be specified in the CV) ;
 - A working experience on projects or programs financed by Technical and Financial Partners.
 - A working experience in one of the rural areas (the knowledge of the chosen region will be an asset) ;
 - Hold category A driving license and know how to drive a motorbike, **compulsory**.
